## ➤ Tips for viewing electronic documentation:

The cursor changes to a pointing hand  when it touches a hyperlink to a chapter, section, subsection, cross-reference, or figure.

- **Hyperlinked references** are in the Contents, Index, and throughout the publication. Most cross-references and hypertext links are blue and underlined. Click a page or figure reference to display the corresponding page or figure.

**Note:** Refer to the CONTENTS.PDF for references to other publication titles contained on the CD. Click the CD Contents bookmark to view the CONTENTS.PDF.

- **Bookmarks** display in the left window when a publication opens. A right arrowhead  indicates another level of headings within a chapter, section, or subsection. Click the arrowhead to display those additional headings. Scroll the list using the window's scroll bar. Click a heading name to go to that chapter, section, or subsection.

Use these buttons on the toolbar to view thumbnails, use bookmarks, or search for text in a publication.



Click the Show/Hide Navigation Panel button to display the Bookmarks and Thumbnails tab.



Click the Find button to begin a text search. Enter the text for the search in the Acrobat Find dialog box, and click Find. When your text is found, press F3 to search for the next occurrence.
