

Natural as a Server - Overview

This documentation describes the use of Natural as a Server and the Natural Server Monitor.

The following topics are covered:

- **Natural as a Server under OS/390** explains how Natural can act as a server in a client/server environment under OS/390.
- **Natural as a Server under CICS** explains how Natural can act as a server in a client/server environment under the TP monitor CICS; describes the functionality and the installation of the Natural CICS interface in a server environment and informs about restrictions that apply in such an environment.
- **Introduction to the Natural Server Monitor** explains the features that are available with the Natural Server Monitor: the server monitor facility, the system management client, the monitor communication protocol and the monitor system architecture.
- **Monitor Client NATMOPI** provides information on the usage of the NATMOPI Monitor Client which can be executed in batch mode, under TSO and under the OS/390 UNIX shell.
