Natural for DB2 Server Stub

Natural for DB2 server stub is created from the NDBSTUB macro. Its parameters are used to determine the Natural server environment used to execute DB2 procedures written in Natural.

New Natural Statement CALLDBPROC

The CALLDBPROC statement allows you to call DB2 stored procedures. It supports the result set mechanism of **DB2 Version 5 (???)** and it allows you to call DB2 stored procedures written in Natural.

Issuing DB2 Commands from Natural

The DB2 commands part of the Natural Tools for DB2 enables you to issue DB2 commands from a Natural environment.

Procedure Maintenance

Procedure Maintenance provides easier handling of stored procedures, data areas and PARMLISTS.

Writing Stored Procedures in Natural

You can write stored procedures in Natural as described in the relevant section in Statements and System Variables.
