

PM - Print Mode

This Natural profile and session parameter is for all platforms, however, some of its settings are platform-dependent.

It indicates how fields are to be printed or displayed.

Within a Natural session, the profile parameter PM can be overridden by the session parameter PM.

Possible settings	C	<p>On Mainframes: An alternative character set is to be used. It can be defined by the profile parameters TAB1 and TAB2.</p> <p>On UNIX and Windows: Not available.</p>
	P	<p>On Mainframes: The primary (standard) character set is to be used.</p> <p>On UNIX and Windows: Not available.</p>
	I	<p>Defines that field settings are to be displayed in inverse direction; that is, from right to left (for example, for use in Middle Eastern countries). This setting requires a specific localized version of Natural.</p> <p>On Mainframes: See also the module NATPM in the Natural source library for further information.</p>
	R	<p>On all platforms: Resets the PM=I setting to normal (left to right) display direction. PM=R can only be specified dynamically.</p>
	CI, CR, PI, PR	<p>On Mainframes: Combinations of the individual values are possible.</p> <p>On UNIX and Windows: Not available.</p>
