

DUE - Dump for Specific Errors

This Natural profile parameter is for mainframes only.

This parameter allows you to specify Natural error numbers for which a storage dump shall be taken. This may be helpful to get a dump for the analysis of a specific error situation by Software AG personnel.

| Possible settings | List of numbers 1-9999 or OFF | One or more error numbers for which a dump shall be taken. If DUE is specified multiple times, all error numbers are saved in one table. OFF deletes the table and any error numbers specified previously are removed. |
| Default setting | OFF | |
| Dynamic specification | YES | |
| Specification within session | YES | Terminal command %DUE |

If an error occurs which has been specified by DUE, a program check is forced. If parameter DU=OFF is set, it will be changed to DU=ON. For further processing, the DU parameter setting is honored.

Examples:

```
DUE=1302
DUE=( 6501,6502,6503,1500 )
DUE=OFF
```
