

TTYPE - Terminal Type

This Natural profile parameter is for mainframes only.

It allows you to specify the terminal type used - in TP environments in which this information is not supplied automatically - so that Natural can activate the appropriate converter routine for attribute sequences to operate that type of terminal.

Possible settings	1-4 characters	The setting specified with the TTYPE parameter must be defined as a valid terminal device type in the NTDVCE macro of the NATCONFIG module, see Configuration Tables - Module NATCONFIG.
Default setting	IBM	3270
	Siemens	The setting defined in PDN, unless overridden by the parameter T975X (see Installing the Natural TIAM Interface in the Natural for Mainframes Installation Guide).
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	YES	The TTYPE parameter has the same function as the terminal command %T= (described in the Natural Reference documentation).

If you use the TTYPE parameter, it is no longer necessary to execute a program containing a SET CONTROL 'T=...' statement at the start of the session in order to set the terminal type.
