

# WSIZE - Size of Buffer Area for Screen Images

This Natural profile parameter is for mainframes only.

It determines the maximum size of the buffer area where the screen images are stored that are saved when the **terminal command** %WA has been entered.

Alternatively, you can use the equivalent Natural profile parameter DS or macro NTDS (see Using Optional Macros in a Natural Parameter Module in the Natural Operations for Mainframes documentation) to specify the buffer size.

The buffer area will be created only **after** %WA has been entered.

<b>Possible settings</b>	1 - 64	Size of buffer area in KB.  If the required space is not available, the screen images cannot be saved with the terminal command "%WA".
	0	The terminal command "%WA" cannot be used to save screen images.
