

LC - Leading Characters

With this session parameter, you can specify leading characters that are displayed immediately before a field output by a DISPLAY statement. The width of the output column is enlarged accordingly.

The session parameters LC and IC are mutually exclusive.

Possible settings	Any character	Up to 10 characters may be specified. Leading characters may optionally be specified enclosed within apostrophes, in which case, any characters can be specified. Any character string specified which contains a closing parenthesis or a quotation mark must be enclosed within apostrophes. The character "^" is used to represent a blank in a character string not enclosed within apostrophes.	
Default setting	None

DISPLAY LC=*
```
