

PD - NATPAGE Page Dataset

Note:

This parameter is for Mainframes and UNIX only.

| Parameter | Possible Values | Default Value | Applicable Statements |
|-----------|-----------------|---------------|-----------------------|
| PD | 0 to 255 | 50 | SET GLOBALS |

This session parameter is used to specify the maximum number of pages (screens) which can be captured with the NATPAGE utility.

If this number is exceeded, each additional screen will overwrite an already captured screen, thus gradually overwriting the oldest screens, i.e. those captured first (wrap-around technique).

The captured screens are stored in the Natural system file FUSER.

For further information on the NATPAGE utility, see the terminal commands %E, %I, %O, %P and %S.

Example:

```
SET GLOBALS PD=60
```
