

NTUTAB2 Macro - Overwriting of Upper-to-Lower-Case Translation Table

The NTUTAB2 macro allows you to overwrite the definitions in the translation table NTUTAB2 as contained in the configuration module NATCONFG. The NTUTAB2 table is used for upper-to-lower-case translation.

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NTUTAB2 Syntax

You specify the NTUTAB2 macro in the same way as the NTTAB macro; that is you specify pairs of characters, the first character of a pair being an upper-case character to be translated, the second character of a pair being the lower-case character into which the upper-case character is to be translated.

You can specify each character either as the one-byte character itself (enclosed in apostrophes) or as the two-byte hexadecimal representation of that character.

NTUTAB2 Alternative

Instead of the NTUTAB2 macro, you can also use the dynamic profile parameter UTAB2.
