

CHECK

CCHECK

This command is used to check if the syntax of the source code currently in the editor work area contains any errors.

Syntax checking is also performed as part of the RUN, STOW and CATALL commands.

In online mode: Syntax checking stops when a syntax error is detected, and the source-code line that contains the error is marked with **E** in the corresponding editor.

In batch mode: Syntax checking continues until all statements have been checked, and all errors detected are included in the output listing.

Note:

For LDAs, PDAs, GDAs and maps the CHECK command cannot be invoked from the Next prompt.
