This command is for Mainframes and UNIX only.

**Note for Natural Single Point of Development Users:**

This command is not available via the command line in a remote development environment, because DDMs are listed in the tree view under the node DDM and all functions of the SYSDDM utility are available via the context menu or the menu bar.

<b>SYSDDM</b>

This command invokes the SYSDDM utility. The SYSDDM utility is used to perform all functions needed for the creation and maintenance of Natural data definition modules (DDMs).
