

LIST COUNT

This command applies to all platforms.

```

*
LIST COUNT name<
name>
name*
```

You use the LIST COUNT command to list the number of Natural objects in your current library.

The following command options are available:

LIST COUNT	Displays the total number of objects.
LIST COUNT *	Displays the number of objects broken down by object types.
LIST COUNT name<	Displays the number of objects whose names are less/equal <i>name</i> .
LIST COUNT name>	Displays the number of objects whose names are greater/equal <i>name</i> .
LIST COUNT name*	Displays the number of only those objects whose names begin with <i>name</i> .

Note:

If there are objects listed under object type "undefined", this indicates that the library contains objects whose version is not compatible.
