

# TECH

This command applies to all platforms.

TECH
------

This command displays the following technical and other information about your Natural session:

- user ID
- library ID
- Natural version and SM level
- startup transaction
- Natural Security indicator
- operating system name and version
- machine class
- hardware
- TP monitor (only for Mainframes and Windows (\*TPSYS) in remote configuration)
- terminal type
- terminal ID (Mainframes and Windows in remote configuration only)
- device type
- last command issued
- information on the last error that occurred
- names, database IDs and file numbers of all currently active steplibs
- names, types and levels of the currently active programming object and all objects on higher levels, as well as the line numbers of the statements invoking the subordinate programming objects (Mainframes and UNIX only).

**Note for Mainframes, UNIX and Windows in character applications only:**

To display this information from any point in an application, you can use the terminal command %<TECH. In addition, the following information is still available under Windows: Names, types and levels of the currently active programming object and all objects on higher levels.

**Note for Windows platforms:**

This command is also available in a remote session.  
All information can be read in batch mode.
