

%K and %KP - Simulate PF- and PA-Key

Command Syntax

```
%K { nn }  
    { Pn }
```

These terminal commands can be used to simulate the terminal function (PF, ENTER) and program attention (PA) keys.

Command	Function
%Knn	Simulates the terminal function key numbered <i>nn</i> (PF1 to PF24). This permits PF-keys 13-24 to be assigned to PF-keys 1-12, or the activation of PF-keys not available on the keyboard used. Natural for Mainframes: This terminal command also makes function keys available in batch mode.
%K0	Simulates the ENTER key.
%KPn	Simulates the program attention key numbered <i>n</i> (PA1 to PA3) (see %Knn).
