

Object Handler - Library Selection

This function is used to list and select the Natural libraries available in the system file and specified by the database ID (DBID) and the file number (FNR).

The instructions below show how to invoke and execute the function by using advanced-user mode (see the relevant section):

To list and select libraries

- On the Unload Natural Library Objects screen, choose "Select library" and press ENTER, or choose PF4/SeLib. The Select Library window appears with a list of all libraries available and the corresponding DBIDs and FNRs.
- Select a library or specify a range of libraries (see the table below).
- Press ENTER

The Select Library screen provides the following columns:

Select	Select a library by entering any single character in the input field next to the library desired.
Library	Lists all Natural libraries available and provides the option to enter a range of libraries in the input fields of the first row: see also Name in the section Name, Date and Time Specification.
DBID/FNR	<p>The DBID and FNR of the Natural system file where the libraries are stored.</p> <p>If no values (or 0) are specified, the current FUSER or FNAT system file is used.</p> <p>These fields cannot be changed if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The view function (see the relevant section) is used, A library is selected for the load or scan function, Natural Library Objects Exceptions are specified (see the relevant section in Object Specification).
