

AUTORPC - Automatic Natural RPC Execution

This Natural profile parameter is for UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows platforms only.

Note for mainframes:

Use the keyword parameter AUTORPC of the NTRPC macro for static specification, or the subparameter with the same name of the profile parameter RPC.

This parameter determines whether or not Natural RPC will automatically try to execute a subprogram remotely (on the server side) which was not found locally (on the client side). For details see Stubs and Automatic RPC in the Natural Remote Procedure Call documentation.

AUTORPC is specified on the client side only.

Possible settings	ON	Natural RPC will automatically try to execute it remotely.
	OFF	Natural RPC will not automatically try to execute it remotely. If AUTORPC=OFF, you can execute CALLNATs remotely using stubs.
Default setting	OFF	
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	NO
