

NTTAB1 Macro - Overwriting of Alternate Output Translation Table

The NTTAB1 macro allows you to overwrite the definitions in the translation table NTTAB1 as contained in the configuration module NATCONFIG. The NTTAB1 table is the alternative output translation table for the secondary character set used when the profile/session parameter PM=C is set.

NTTAB1 Syntax

You specify the NTTAB1 macro in the same way as the NTTAB macro; that is you specify pairs of characters, the first character of a pair being the character to be translated, the second character of a pair being the character into which the first character is to be translated.

You can specify each character either as the one-byte character itself (enclosed in apostrophes) or as the two-byte hexadecimal representation of that character.

NTTAB1 Alternative

Instead of the NTTAB1 macro, you can also use the dynamic profile parameter TAB1.
