

# UNLOCK

**Note:**

This command applies to Windows platforms and in a remote development environment only.

With the UNLOCK command you can view the locked objects and unlock these if needed. This command is recommended for administrator use only

 **To select locked objects do the following:**

1. In the "Menu Bar" select "Tools", choose "Development Tools" and select "Unlock Objects" or type Unlock in the command line.
2. Following selection criteria can be set:
  - Application Name
  - Library
  - DBID
  - FNR
  - Object Name
  - Object Type

The search criteria can be narrowed with the additional parameters "Locked user ID" and "Locked date".

 **To unlock the objects do the following:**

1. If locked objects are found, they will be listed in the Results Window.
2. Select the objects to be unlocked.
3. With the right mouse button select "Unlock Objects" out of the context-menu.
4. The selection list can be deleted by selecting an object and by pressing the right mouse button select "Delete Tab" out of the context-menu.

It is possible to type in the name of a single object and it will be unlocked immediately.

The UNLOCK command can be set for each user profile in Natural Security.
