

LC - Lower to Upper Case Translation

This Natural profile parameter is for:

- mainframes
- UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

This parameter controls lower-case to upper-case translation of input characters.

To disable or enable lower-case to upper-case translation dynamically within the active Natural session, you should use the terminal commands %L or %U, respectively.

Mainframes

Possible settings	ON	No translation of lower-case characters to upper case is performed.
	OFF	All lower-case characters entered from a video terminal are translated to upper case by Natural.
Default setting	OFF	
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	YES	

Lower/upper-case translation can also be performed by a TP monitor before control is given to Natural. The corresponding TP-monitor parameters for lower/upper-case translation also have to be reviewed to ensure correct translation.

A user-supplied translation table can be used to perform translation from lower case to upper case; see NTUTAB1 Macro.

UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

Possible settings	ON	No translation of lower-case characters to upper case is performed.
	OFF	All lower-case characters entered from a video terminal are translated to upper case by Natural.
Default setting	ON	
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	NO
