

LS - Line Size

This Natural profile parameter is for:

- mainframes
- UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

It parameter indicates the maximum number of characters permitted per line for DISPLAY, INPUT, PRINT and WRITE statements. Together with the profile parameter PS, it defines the amount of page buffer space acquired during Natural initialization.

Possible settings	35 - 250, or 0	Maximum number of characters permitted per line. LS=0 indicates that the output device line size is to be used.
Default setting	0	In online mode, the default setting will always be set to the physical line size, even if LS has been set to another setting at the start of the Natural session.
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	NO	Within a Natural session, the profile parameter LS can be overridden by the session parameter LS .
