

WSIZE - Size of Buffer Area for Screen Images

This Natural profile parameter is for mainframes only.

It determines the maximum size of the buffer area where the screen images are stored that are saved when the **terminal command** %WA has been entered. The buffer area will be created only **after** %WA has been entered.

Possible settings	1 - 64	Size of buffer area in KB.
Default setting	12	
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	NO	

If WSIZE=0 or if the required space is not available, the screen images cannot be saved with the terminal command "%WA".
