Dear Natural Construct Customer,

This letter is to inform you of some minor errors and omissions in the *Natural Construct Installation and Operations Manual for OpenVMS* (Manual number: CST333-010VMS).

On page 26, in Step 2 of the Library level portion of the installation, you are instructed to select the Natural Parameter Module. This install menu option should only be selected to change the parameter module from the default CSTPARM to something else. It will not allow you to select CSTPARM until after Step 3 has been executed, which copies CSTPARM into the Natural environment. In addition, it is implied that if you retain the default, you are not required to execute the next step, but this is not true. Step 3 is a required step in either case, but different parameters will have to be changed based on the starting parameter module.

On page 28, in the list of parameters that must be checked in the parameter module, it states that work files 1 and 5 and report device 1 must be defined appropriately. In fact, work file 4 must also be defined to point to NATTMP:NATWORK04.TXT, and the printer device for report 5 must also be defined to the logical name NATREP05, similar to report 1. In addition, it is necessary to ensure that Natural has set up the NATTMP logical name to point to the same directory as the TMP\_PATH entry in the Local Configuration file, as this is not guaranteed to be the case. Note also that the default CSTPARM parameter module on the Alpha/AXP version of Natural Construct V333 for OpenVMS assumes that NATTMP points to SAG\$ROOT:[NATURAL.TMP]. If this is not the case, the work file settings will have to be modified accordingly.
