

# DD - Day Differential

This Natural profile parameter is for:

- mainframes
- UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

It adjusts the current machine date (as read by using the internal machine time) by adding/subtracting any number of days to/from it. This makes it possible to re-run an application that was to be run at a certain date but for some reason could not be run at that date.

The parameter is specified as "DD=+*nn*" or "DD=-*nn*" (*nn* being the number of days).

## Mainframes

<b>Possible settings</b>	-32767 to +32767	Machine date is adjusted. Specification of "+" is optional.
<b>Default setting</b>	0	No adjustment is made.
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	YES	
<b>Specification within session</b>	NO

<b>Possible settings</b>	-10953 to +10953	Machine date is adjusted. Specification of "+" is optional.
<b>Default setting</b>	0	No adjustment is made.
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	YES
