

CF - Character for Terminal Commands

This Natural profile parameter is for:

- mainframes
- UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

It specifies the control character for Natural terminal commands; that is, the character which is to be used as the first character of any terminal command.

Possible settings	any special character	A terminal command must begin with the character specified.
	OFF	No control character for terminal commands is available. Terminal commands issued with SET CONTROL statements, however, are still accepted.
Default setting	%	A terminal command must begin with the character "%".
Dynamic specification	YES	
Specification within session	YES	Within a Natural session, the profile parameter CF can be overridden by the session parameter CF .

Mainframes

The character specified with the CF parameter must not be the same as the one specified with the HI parameter (help character) or IA parameter (input assign character); it should not be the same as the one specified with the DC parameter (decimal character) or ID parameter (input delimiter character).

UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows

The character specified with the CF parameter must not be the same as the one specified with the IA parameter (input assign character), the DC parameter (decimal character) or the ID parameter (input delimiter character); it should not be the same as the one specified with the HI parameter (help character).
