

# V22COMP - Compatibility with Inconsistent Version 2.2 Syntax

This Natural profile parameter is for UNIX/OpenVMS and Windows platforms only.

It provides a compatibility option for inconsistent Natural Version 2.2 syntax. Use this option for a smooth transition from Version 2.2 to Version 3.1 or above.

**Note:**

The V22COMP option will be available only for a limited period of time to allow a smooth transition to the syntax of Version 3.1 or above. It will be removed again with a subsequent release of Natural.

The following inconsistent syntax constructions that were not intercepted by Version 2.2 lead to a syntax error with Version 3.1 or above:

DEFINE DATA: inconsistent number of decimal digits in constant setting;

DEFINE WINDOW: specified window size smaller than minimum.
