## Accelerators Grouped by Categories

### Generally Available Accelerators

The following table shows the accelerators that are available in Windows Explorer, on a selected node in the library workspace or in an active list view.

Accelerator	Description
<b>ALT-ENTER</b>	Display properties of Natural objects
<b>CTRL-C</b>	Copies.
<b>CTRL-O</b>	Opens a Natural object or a list view.
<b>CTRL-P</b>	Prints an object.
<b>CTRL-V</b>	Pastes.
<b>CTRL-X</b>	Cuts.
<b>DEL</b>	Deletes.
<b>ENTER</b>	Opens or executes Natural object or opens a list view.

The following table shows the accelerators that are available anywhere inside Natural.

<b>Accelerator</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>ALT-1</b>	Toggles view of library workspace.
<b>ALT-2</b>	Toggles view of application workspace.
<b>ALT-3</b>	Toggles view of command line.
<b>ALT-4</b>	Toggles view of status bar.
<b>ALT-5</b>	Toggles view of result list.
<b>ALT-F4</b>	Exits the Natural session.
<b>CTRL-D</b>	Toggles between the command line and the active MDI window.
<b>CTRL-T</b>	Toggles between the result view and the active MDI window.
<b>CTRL-TAB</b>	Makes next MDI window active.
<b>CTRL-W</b>	Toggles between the library workspace and the active MDI window.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-TAB</b>	Makes previous MDI window active.

## Dialog Editor Accelerators

The following table shows the accelerators that are available in the active dialog editor.

<b>Accelerator</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>CTRL-A</b>	Selects all.
<b>CTRL-E</b>	Checks an object.
<b>CTRL-F</b>	Finds items.
<b>CTRL-H</b>	Replaces items.
<b>CTRL-P</b>	Prints an object.
<b>CTRL-R</b>	Runs an object.
<b>CTRL-S</b>	Saves an object.
<b>CTRL-V</b>	Pastes.
<b>CTRL-X</b>	Cuts.
<b>CTRL-Y</b>	Performs a redo.
<b>CTRL-Z</b>	Performs an undo.
<b>CTRL-ALT-DOWN</b>	Aligns selected controls down.
<b>CTRL-ALT-E</b>	Opens the dialog event handlers dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-G</b>	Opens the global data area dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-H</b>	Opens the help organizer dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-I</b>	Opens the timers dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-L</b>	Opens the local data area dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-LEFT</b>	Aligns selected controls left.
<b>CTRL-ALT-M</b>	Opens the menu dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-O</b>	Opens the comment dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-P</b>	Opens the parameter data area dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-Q</b>	Displays control sequence numbers.
<b>CTRL-ALT-RIGHT</b>	Aligns selected controls right.
<b>CTRL-ALT-S</b>	Opens the inline subroutine dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-T</b>	Opens the toolbar dialog.
<b>CTRL-ALT-UP</b>	Aligns selected controls up.
<b>CTRL-ALT-X</b>	Opens context menu dialog.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-D</b>	Deletes line.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-E</b>	Opens event handlers for selected control.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-F9</b>	Aligns selected controls centered.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-K</b>	Delete to end of line.
<b>F3</b>	Repeats "Find items".
<b>F9</b>	Vertical center of selected controls.
<b>SHIFT-F9</b>	Horizontal center of selected controls.

## Program Editor Accelerators

The following table shows the accelerators that are available in the active program editor.

<b>Accelerator</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>CTRL-A</b>	Selects all.
<b>CTRL-E</b>	Checks an object.
<b>CTRL-F</b>	Finds items.
<b>CTRL-G</b>	Goto.
<b>CTRL-H</b>	Replaces items.
<b>CTRL-P</b>	Prints an object.
<b>CTRL-R</b>	Runs an object.
<b>CTRL-S</b>	Saves an object.
<b>CTRL-V</b>	Pastes.
<b>CTRL-X</b>	Cuts.
<b>CTRL-Y</b>	Performs a redo.
<b>CTRL-Z</b>	Performs an undo.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-D</b>	Deletes line.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-K</b>	Delete to end of line.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-R</b>	Starts recording.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-S</b>	Stops recording.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-P</b>	Replays recording.
<b>F3</b>	Repeats "Find items".
<b>F6</b>	Toggles between split windows.

## Data Area Editor Accelerators

The following table shows the accelerators that are available in the active data area editor.

<b>Accelerator</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>CTRL-A</b>	Selects all.
<b>CTRL-E</b>	Checks an object.
<b>CTRL-F</b>	Finds items.
<b>CTRL-H</b>	Replaces items.
<b>CTRL-P</b>	Prints an object.
<b>CTRL-R</b>	Runs an object.
<b>CTRL-S</b>	Saves an object.
<b>CTRL-V</b>	Pastes.
<b>CTRL-X</b>	Cuts.
<b>CTRL-Y</b>	Performs a redo.
<b>CTRL-Z</b>	Performs an undo.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-D</b>	Deletes line.

<b>ALT-3</b>	Toggles view of command line.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>ALT-4</b>	Toggles view of status bar.	Anywhere inside Natural
<b>ALT-5</b>	Toggles view of result list.	Anywhere inside Natural
<b>ALT-ENTER</b>	Display properties of Natural objects	Selected node in library workspace or active list view.
<b>ALT-F4</b>	Exits the Natural session.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>ALT-RIGHT</b>	Horizontal spacing.	Active Dialog Editor
<b>ALT-UP</b>	Vertical spacing.	Active Dialog Editor
<b>CTRL-A</b>	Selects all.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-C</b>	Copies.	Windows explorer, selected node in library workspace or in active list view.

<b>CTRL-D</b>	Toggles between the command line and the active MDI window.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>CTRL-E</b>	Checks an object.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-F</b>	Finds items.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-F4</b>	Closes the active MDI window (list view or editor).	Active MDI Window.
<b>CTRL-G</b>	Goto.	Active Program Editor.
<b>CTRL-H</b>	Replaces items.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-N</b>	Creates a new Program.	Active environment.
<b>CTRL-O</b>	Opens a Natural object or a list view.	Selected Node in library workspace or active list view.
<b>CTRL-P</b>	Prints an object.	Active Editor, selected node in library workspace or active list view.
<b>CTRL-R</b>	Runs an object.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-S</b>	Saves an object.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-T</b>	Toggles between the result view and the active MDI window.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>CTRL-TAB</b>	Makes next MDI window active.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>CTRL-V</b>	Pastes.	Windows explorer, selected node in library workspace or in active list view.
<b>CTRL-W</b>	Toggles between the library workspace and the active MDI window.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>CTRL-X</b>	Cuts.	Windows explorer, selected node in library workspace or in active list view.
<b>CTRL-Y</b>	Performs a redo.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-Z</b>	Performs an undo.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-ALT-C</b>	Displays source code.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-ALT-DOWN</b>	Aligns selected controls down.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-ALT-E</b>	Opens the dialog event handlers dialog.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-ALT-G</b>	Opens the global data area dialog.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-ALT-H</b>	Opens the help organizer dialog.	Active Dialog Editor.

<b>CTRL-SHIFT-D</b>	Deletes line.	Active editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-E</b>	Opens event handlers for selected control.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-F9</b>	Aligns selected controls centered.	Active Dialog Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-R</b>	Starts recording.	Active Program Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-S</b>	Stops recording.	Active Program Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-P</b>	Replays recording.	Active Program Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-I</b>	Jumps to next level.	Active Data Area Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-J</b>	Jumps to previous level.	Active Data Area Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-K</b>	Delete to end of line.	Active Editor.
<b>CTRL-SHIFT-TAB</b>	Makes previous MDI window active.	Anywhere inside Natural.
<b>DEL</b>	Deletes.	Selected node in library workspace or in active list view.
<b>ENTER</b>	Opens or executes Natural object or opens a list view.	Selected node in library workspace or active list view.
<b>F3</b>	Repeats "Find items".	Active editor.
<b>F6</b>	Toggles between split windows.	Active Program Editor.
<b>F9</b>	Vertical center of selected controls.	Active Dialog Editor
<b>SHIFT-F9</b>	Horizontal center of selected controls.	Active Dialog Editor
