

# NUCNAME - Name of Shared Nucleus

This Natural profile parameter is for mainframes only.

With this parameter, you specify the name of the (environment-independent) shared nucleus if it is to be loaded dynamically and not linked to the environment-dependent nucleus.

<b>Possible settings</b>	1 to 8 characters	Valid load module name.
<b>Default setting</b>	none	
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	YES	By specifying this parameter dynamically, you are able to use different shared nuclei (for example, for production and for testing) together with the same environment-dependent nucleus without having to relink the nucleus.
<b>Specification within session</b>	NO	

The NUCNAME parameter is ignored if it is specified in a parameter string activated by a SYS or PROFILE profile parameter or in an alternative parameter module (as specified with the PARM profile parameter).
