

LIST COUNT

Note:

This command applies to all platforms.

<u>L</u>IST COUNT	$\left[\begin{array}{l} * \\ name < \\ name > \\ name * \end{array} \right]$
--------------------------	---

You use the LIST COUNT command to list the number of Natural objects in your current library.

The following command options are available:

LIST COUNT	will display the total number of objects.
LIST COUNT *	will display the number of objects broken down by object types.
LIST COUNT <i>name</i><	will display the number of objects whose names are less/equal <i>name</i> .
LIST COUNT <i>name</i>>	will display the number of objects whose names are greater/equal <i>name</i> .
LIST COUNT <i>name</i>*	will display the number of only those objects whose names begin with <i>name</i> .

Note:

If there are objects listed under object type "undefined", this indicates that the library contains objects whose version is not compatible (for example, Natural Version 1.2 maps).
