Typographical Conventions

The following symbols are used for instructions:

Symbol	Description
	Marks the beginning of a set of instructions to complete a task.
• One step	Indicates that the task consists of one step.
1. First step	Indicates that the task consists of several steps (this being the first).

Syntax Conventions

In descriptions of command syntax, the following conventions are used:

Convention	Description
Commands, program names etc.	Indicates anything which you must type in exactly as it appears. For example, if you are asked to enter FNR, you must type in all the characters in bold type exactly as they are printed.
<i>file number</i>	Placeholders to represent variable information, which you must supply. For example, if you are asked to enter <i>file number</i> , you must type the actual number of the required file.
